## Arrivals, Tardies, Early Dismissals & Attendance

### **INQUIRER**

Students who are INQUIRERS are curious about the world. They can conduct research independently. They love learning and discovering new things and will carry this love of learning with them throughout life.

How can parents help to develop students who are Inquirers at home?

- Take your child exploring with you even if it's just walking down the street, observing, taking notes and asking questions about everything that you observe.
- After reading a book, spend some time considering how the people in the book were inquirers. Was someone in the book curious? About what? Was there a mystery to solve? What was it? How was it solved? Who solved it? Some books to consider:
  - o Counting on Frank by Rod Clement
  - o The Day of Ahmed's Secret by Florence Parry Heide
  - o Goldilocks and the Three Bears by Jan Brett
  - o The Snowy Day by Ezra Jack Keats
- Model being an inquirer. Admit when you don't know the answer to a problem or a question and seek out
