What is an IB Education?

IB Schools develop well-rounded students with character who respond to challenges with optimism and an open mind, are confident in their own identities, make ethical decisions, are globally aware and join with others in celebrating our common humanity, and are prepared to apply what they learn in real-world, complex, and unpredictable situations. IB students are given a unique education experience that enables them to engage with people in an increasingly globalized, rapidly changing world and can lead them to some of the highest-ranking universities around the world.

A vital element of an IB education is the transformative and ongoing professional development opportunities for educators. Each year, Caleb Greenwood, along with schools from all over the world, send groups of teachers to collaborative professional development sessions, in which teachers and school leaders work together to evaluate, reflect on, refine, and grow our program of inquiry.

What is the Primary Years Program?

The PYP prepares students to become active, caring, lifelong learners who demonstrate respect for themselves and others and have the capacity to participate in the world around them. The PYP is designed for students aged 3 to 12 and focuses on the development of the whole child as an inquirer, both in the classroom and in the world outside. The PYP framework is guided by six transdisciplinary themes of global significance and is delivered through site-developed curriculum based on national and local standards.
