Caleb Greenwood Essential Agreements for Shared Spaces

ARRIVAL

Arrival before 7:30 is not permitted
Arrive 7:30-7:45 for breakfast; take your belongings to the cafeteria
Arrive 7:45-7:55 if not eating breakfast
When dropping off your belongings, do so quickly, respect others' things and then move away from the hallway
When the warning bell rings, line up based on your classroom's procedures

BATHROOMS

Use your assigned bathroom and use it for its intended purpose, not to play or hide
Use only what you need & always flush, then wash your hands and turn off the water
Respect privacy
Primary students always use primary bathrooms
Intermediate students use intermediate bathrooms, except at lunch recess, when they are allowed to use primary's
Let an adult know if something needs attention

ASSEMBLIES & EVENTS

(during school hours)
Be on time, stay seated in your assigned area and listen for directions & announcements
Use good audience manners, listen & participate and wait for & follow signals
Leave fidgets, pens, pencils, etc. in your classroom

ASSEMBLIES & EVENTS

(outside of school hours)
Follow Essential Agreements
Stay with your parents/guardians
Take care of our school

LUNCH

Line up single file
Walk when arriving and leaving
Only take what you will eat & drink
When eating inside, sit at grade level table and use an indoor voice
When eating outside, do not sit or eat in hallways
Use your manners, sit while you eat, do not share food and do not throw food
Clean up after yourself and throw away your trash when you are dismissed
Raise your hand to get out of your seat, ask for help and use the bathroom
Go around the primary bathroom hallway, not through it, when putting your lunch away; do not go through the front lobby to put your lunch away

HALLWAYS

ALWAYS WALK
Hallways are for travel, not for hanging out, playing or eating
Be aware that students are in their classrooms learning, so always use a quiet voice and please do not yell or scream, or knock on, hit or kick walls, doors or windows
When getting your snack at recess or dropping off your lunch, do so and then exit the hallway
First graders may sit, not play, on their benches at recess, but second through sixth grade hallways are not for hanging out, playing or eating
Poles are there to support the building; please don't climb or swing on them

OFFICE

Only visit the office after you have asked a teacher or a yard duty for permission, and go alone unless directed by the adult
Wait quietly or say "excuse me" to get adult attention and wait patiently for your turn
Adults only allowed behind the counter unless you are invited by the office staff

RECESS

Follow game rules, use equipment properly, show good sportsmanship and use appropriate language
Invite and allow others to play games
Be gentle & do not push, roughhouse or play tackle games; play fighting is not allowed
Apologize if you hurt someone, report injuries to the yard duty and ask how you can help
Stage/oak tree and intermediate quad is for snack only; do not play or hang out on the stage or by intermediate classrooms and backdoors of primary classrooms
Leave cards, balls, and other toys at home
On HOT days, students are allowed to read quietly in the MPR during lunch recess
The brick wall at the end of the second grade wing is an okay place to sit or have a timeout, but not play
MPR courtyard is a no kick zone, including ball wall
When the warning bell rings, immediately stop playing, put your equipment away, get a drink of water, use the restroom, and be in line when the final bell rings

PLAY STRUCTURE

Walk zone only
ALL forms of tag are not allowed
Go down the slide on your bottom, feet first; do not climb up the slides
Do not jump off/over railings
Only use the play structure on your grade level's assigned day

DISMISSAL

Walk your bikes, scooters & skateboards and wear a helmet
Use sidewalks & crosswalks
Go directly to your destination
Leave campus by 2:27pm
If you don't know how you are getting home or someone didn't come get you, go to the office
Follow Essential Agreements on your walk or ride home

GARDEN & HABITAT

Only enter the garden when an adult is present
Stay on pathways and out of planter boxes
Walk, do not run
Use quiet voices
Leave nature where it grows, don't pick flowers, fruit and vegetables
Let the creatures we share our school with be; don't chase, catch, taunt or harm them

EQUIPMENT

Only use equipment assigned to your classroom
PE equipment will not be available except during PE
Classroom equipment left out after recesses will be collected and stored in PE room and may be picked up on Friday after last recess
Kick balls on kickball court, open playground area or field, never in basketball area or against the mural or ball wall
Do not drop kick balls at the end of recess; if this is done, you must get the ball, return it to the correct classroom, be late to class and your teacher will take that time off your next recess
Do not sit on or kick tetherballs

SNACK

Eat snack at the tables in the MPR courtyard at the blue tables or cafeteria tables in front of mural or on the stage under the oak tree in the intermediate courtyard
Get your snack from your backpack and leave the hallway
Throw your trash away in a trash can

RECESS GAMES

Create fair teams and play for fun, not to win
Stay in your place in line; take turns with positions and give others a chance to play
Stay in order in line; everybody gets a turn once before anyone gets another turn
Encourage your teammates and the other team with positive words; no name calling, teasing, put downs or trash talking
When in question, give the other team the benefit of the doubt and move on; do not argue over calls
