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Daily Health Screenings

- Daily Health Screenings Conducted at Home AND School
- Passive Self Screening Conducted by parents using the <u>Frontline</u> <u>Health Portal</u> to perform your daily health check, and report symptoms, exposure and positive tests OR self check in person by answering the questions on the Health Screening poster when you arrive
- Active Screening Conducted on site with temperature checks and symptom/exposure identification upon arrival and as needed

Frontline Health Portal

- Download and follow the instructions for the <u>Frontline Health Portal</u>
- Use the PARENT email address associated with SCUSD, not your child's email address
- Check Infinite Campus for Student ID, or call the front office if you are not able to locate it
- Conduct the Daily Health Check and be prepared to show the "Health Check Cleared" page on your phone when dropping off your child. Your child may then proceed through Active Screening (temperature check)







Daily Health & Safety Practices

- SCUSD Return to Health & Safety Plan
- Physical Distancing six feet at all times
- Face Coverings worn at all times except when consuming food or beverages outside
- Hand Hygiene hand sanitizer when entering/exiting rooms, frequent and proper hand washing as needed
- Daily Disinfecting high touch areas and daily spray in classrooms and office
- CARE Room & Medical Assistant

Voluntary COVID-19 Screening

- Parents may register their child for free, voluntary on-site COVID-19 screening
- Conducted by Health Aide, every two weeks on Tuesday and Thursday, to registered students ONLY
- Parent Information Letter in English & Spanish

Small Group Instruction

- Continue to identify unfinished learning and needs through instruction and assessment
- Small Group Instruction based on student need
- Scheduled time after lunch for flexible groupings Small Group Instruction is not required for all students, only those that show need
- Children not assigned to Small Group Instruction sessions will always have asynchronous learning assignments



Special Education Services

- Special Education and Related Services will continue to be provided virtually as often as possible
- Case managers will work directly with parents and co-teachers to schedule services outside of the student's in-person time, so on DL days and after lunch, whenever possible
- Additional Adult Support, per IEPs, will be in place for in-person learning

Technology

- K-3rd: Chromebooks for each child in every classroom, disinfected daily
- 4th-6th: Bring Chromebooks back and forth; additional devices now available for students who do not have a school-issued device; email Lanetta-Johnson@scusd.edu to request
- Teachers have two devices, polycams, projectors, displays... everything they need!

- Arrival begins at 7:45 am daily
- Parents MUST accompany children for drop off on their FIRST day of in-person learning; AFTER that, if your child is able to answer the passive screening questions and independently navigate social distancing and active screening they may arrive unaccompanied. However, if your child arrives unaccompanied and is unable to adhere to health & safety guidelines while waiting to enter or independently navigate the screening process, you will be contacted and expected to accompany them.
- Parents & Students line up at entry gates on markers/six feet apart
- Staff will ask for evidence of passive screening health check, check roster to ensure they are
 at school on the correct day, then direct them to temperature check
- Parents remain until cohort has been confirmed and temperature checked; students will then be allowed to enter campus
- K/I students walked by greeters to teacher lines in courtyard
- 2nd-6th students proceed directly to classrooms
- First bell rings at 7:55; K/I proceed to classrooms; students arriving after this time will be
 escorted to directly to classrooms
- Instruction & Zoom begin at 8:00am sharp!







- Dismissal begins at 11:00
- Teachers walk students from class to designated Dismissal Gate
- K/I teachers identify parent/guardian before releasing student through gates
- Siblings
 - Identify a meet up location outside Dismissal Gates
 - Specific sibling arrangements can be made and should be coordinated with directly with teachers, not office staff
- Students riding the bus
 - Picked up by staff and walked through Gate C to grab lunch and proceed to bus station
 - 2nd/3rd walk with classes through Gate C

Lunch

Attendance



- Teachers will take attendance daily using Participation-Based Attendance for students at home and Traditional Attendance for students in person
- Instead of marking attendance by 8:30am daily, they will have 24 hours to submit attendance
- Students who engage in synchronous learning directly with their teacher and/or submit asynchronous assignments via Google Classroom will be marked present
- If your child is unable to participate in Concurrent or Distance Learning due to an illness or other personal need, you will report them absent as in a normal school year here: <u>Report an Absence</u>

- Lunch provided, dismissal through Gate E
